ROYALS GO TOP AS SEASON HOT UP

Whites won, and Vikings brought home the bacon against Wests, but the story of round nine of the Griffin Legal John I Dent Cup belongs to Eagles v Royals.

East's tussle with the Queanbeyan Whites deserves attention, no doubt. A cagey, back and forth affair at Griffith Oval produced plenty of stunning rugby with East's wing Tiko Twist scoring the pick of the tries, but ultimately Queanbeyan just had that extra bit of quality, and bagged another bonus-point win, 34-26.

Out at Viking Park, the Champions were reasonably comfortable in victory against the Lions with Ryan Loneragan continuing his impressive points scoring form, taking home two tries and kicking six conversions. Wests once again were competitive right up until the final whistle blew, but ultimately Tuggeranong were too powerful, and ran home winners, 49-21.

Again, as we mentioned, the big game was out at Nicholls where Royals were the victors in the battle of the unbeaten. Indeed, Eagles and Royals had been perfect all season before their matchup, and a 37-32 victory for the Blue-Baggers means they go top, maintaining their blemish free record.

It was a gutsy effort from Royals, truly. Five tries a piece, it was the boot of Pedro Rolando as it so often is that got Royals over the line. Going into the Eagles nest at the best of times is not easy, and Gungahlin had been so impressive up to last week. Round ten, in the context of this season could be crucial.

Gungahlin will be expected to win out at Griffith Oval against East's, though the Suburbs were much improved last week. That puts the pressure on Royals who welcome Vikings to Phillip Oval in the rematch of the 2018 Grand-Final.

Yes, Gungahlin have stolen some headlines at the start of the season, and rightly so with their play but this has been the game we've been waiting for since the draw came out. This game has defined the competition over the past couple of seasons, consistently the two best sides year in year out.

The look of the sides may be a bit different today than it was when Vikings claimed the silverware last year, but the feeling is still there. It's going to be a cracker! A full slate of games also features an interesting contest out at Jamison Enclosed Oval, with West searching for their second win of the season, their opponents the Owls wanting to make a statement having been humbled by Queanbeyan in Round seven.

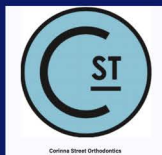
