PREMIER GRADE PREVIEW

Premier rugby continued in round two with some scintillating rugby across the grades, around the capital.

In 2nd grade, Gungahlin Eagles edged out the Queanbeyan Whites 24-17 in what was a meeting of two of the likely finals candidates in the Spence Cup.

Gungahlin were a little more comfortable in 3rd Grade where they were 45-31 victors in an absolute try-fest at Nicholls, Kylan Edwards taking home a hat-trick.

Whites did take their fair share of the spoils from the trip to Gungahlin however, winning 29-19 in 4th Grade as well as their huge result in 1st grade.

On the other side of town, Royals edged out Vikings with the last kick of the game in their matchup in 2nd grade, Tom Hallam shaking off a previous miss to win it for Royals 21-19.

Like Eagles, the Blue Baggers had an easier time in 3's, cruising home to a 32-10 win.

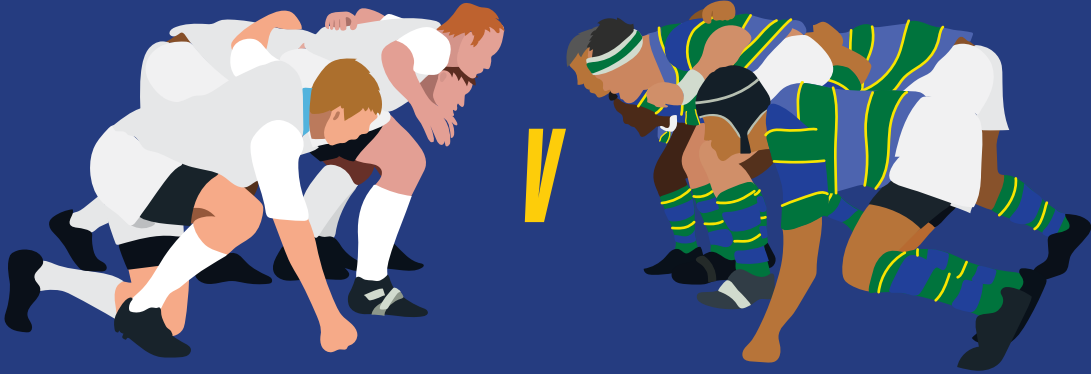
With the sides likely to stay unchanged from last week, only time will tell which of these teams will come out on top and take home the four points.

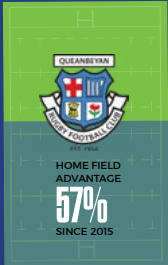

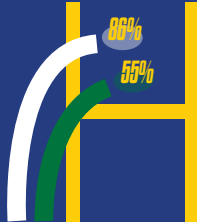

The Canberra Royals will meet the Western Districts Lions in the third round of the John I Dent Cup at Phillip Oval, with both sides in the hunt for their first victories of the 2020 season.

Last years premiers, Royals, will consider themselves unlucky to be placed bottom of the table after two rounds, having shown they are a force with the football in hand.

But defensive improvements are needed from Wayne Southwell's men, which has proved costly in both of their opening fixtures. They were narrowly defeated in round one by two points against the Uni-Norths Owls, despite leading 24-7 early in the second half.

And last week went down 34-26 to the Tuggeranong Vikings. However, Royals must be commended for their efforts, having fought back into the match after trailing 34-7, scoring three tries in the last 10 minutes to narrow the point deficit to eight at full time.

West's will also be disappointed not to have a win to their name and currently sit only one point above their round

three opponents, courtesy of an extra bonus point.

A controversial no try call denied them the chance to equalise in the dying seconds of their first-round thriller against the Gungahlin Eagles, and last week the Lions were narrowly defeated by three points against the Owls.

Head coach Adam Butt, like his opposition, will be looking for strong improvements in defence.

Although, much like Royals, Butt will be encouraged by his sides display in attack so far. Their never say die attitude being evident last week as winger Allan Wratten crossed in the 80th minute of play, to bring the score to 32-29 at full time.

Fullback Declan Meredith will also be hoping to regain form with the boot for West's, after only kicking two from five conversion attempts against the Owls.

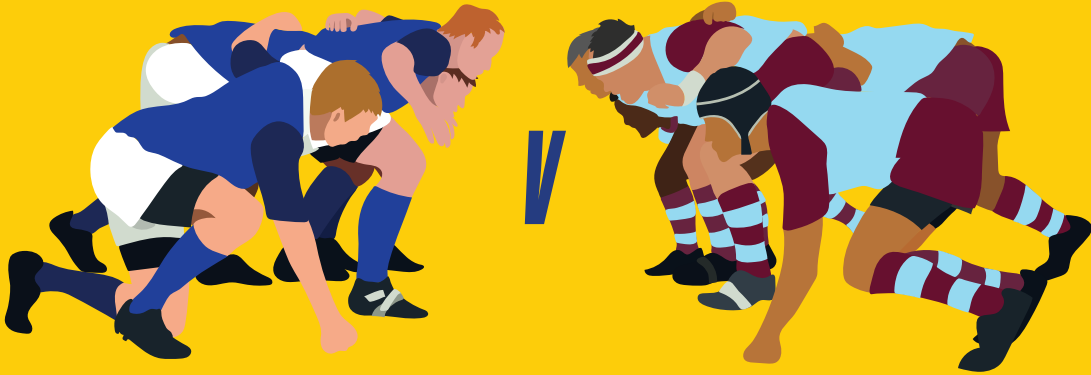

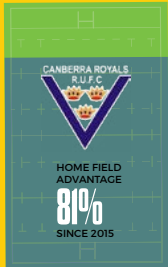

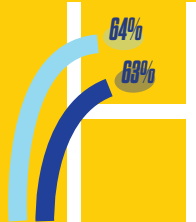

Yet a win over the Eagles would give the Vikings an even more comfortable position and would show that they are a true force to be reckoned with.

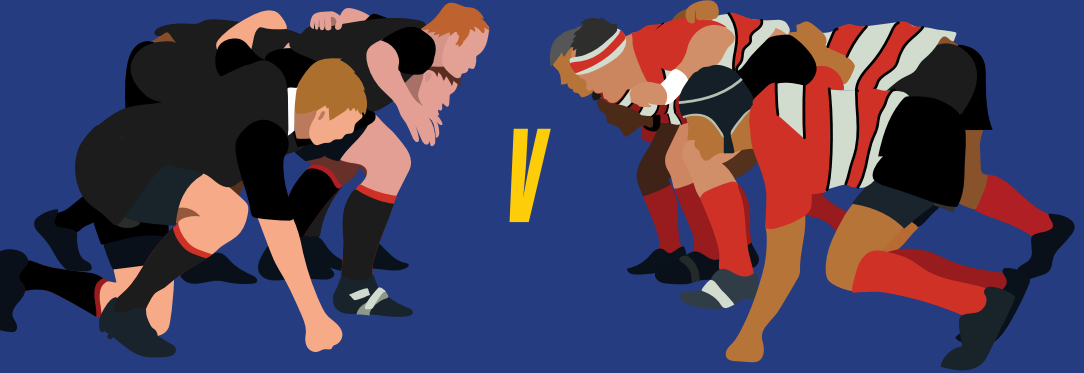
That being said nothing is set in stone till both teams clash on that field and until that first whistle, the tension will have to remain in the air.

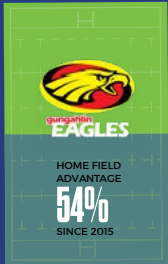

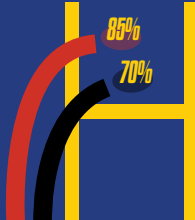

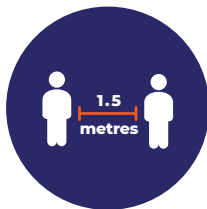
