

NEW REFEREES RESOURCE

WANT TO REFEREE RUGBY UNION IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA?

Step 1 - Register as a referee

Register on Rugby Xplorer

Club Name = **South Australia Referees**

Registration Type = **Match Official**

Type = **Referee/ Referee coach/ Assistant Referee**

Follow prompts to complete registration (note: WWC = Working with Children). All referees MUST HAVE a WWC number. If you do not know it, enter NO for now but you must enter a number before you referee.

There is no payment with registration. An association membership fee of \$40 for senior (over 18) appointed Referees and \$20 for senior ARs will be deducted from your first Match Payment.

Minimum Requirements for new referee

- Register
- Working with children check
- Smart Rugby



Step 2 – Complete 'Smart Rugby' training

This can only be done on a PC via the "Learning Centre" - <https://myaccount.rugbyexplorer.com.au>



Step 3 – Apply for Working with Children check (if you haven't already)
