Yet even though the Owls beat the Whites last time they played they can't be too confident, as the Whites have shown that they can push any team to the limit.

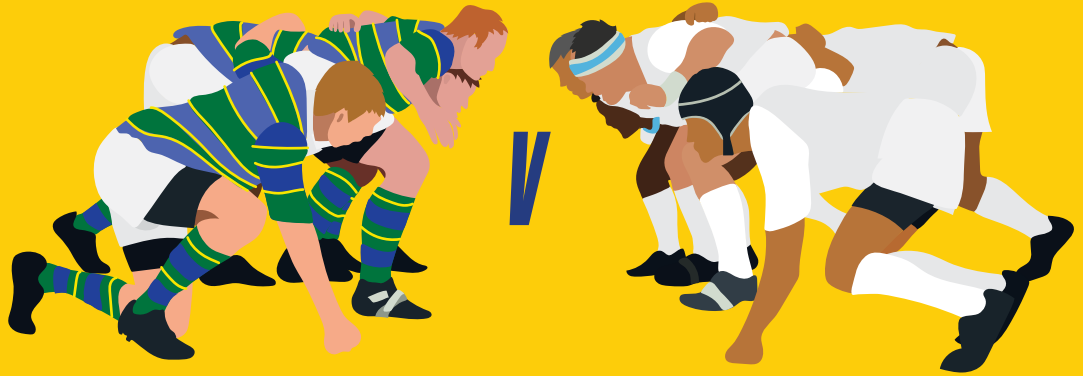
Will the Owls be able to take back the spot on top of the ladder and secure a finals berth? Or will we see an upset made by the underdog Whites squad?
