#### Primary Purpose

The Head Coach – Victorian Schoolboys is responsible for leading the design, delivery and performance of the Victorian Schoolboys Rugby program. The role ensures alignment with Rugby Victoria's Elite Pathways Framework and Rugby Australia's national development principles. The Head Coach will drive a high-quality athlete experience, clear and fair selection processes, and a positive performance culture while preparing players for the next stage in the pathway.

<b>Program design and delivery</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Design and deliver training and competition program in alignment with Rugby Victoria's Elite Pathways Framework.</li><li>Implement best-practice coaching pedagogy, tactical frameworks and skill development progressions as directed within the pathway.</li><li>Lead planning and execution of trials, squad selection events and campaign schedules.</li><li>Monitor standards and ensure training loads and preparations meet pathway performance expectations.</li></ul>
<b>Player development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Create and manage individual development plans aligned with pathway technical and physical benchmarks.</li><li>Provide regular feedback to support ongoing growth and progression.</li><li>Inspire high personal standards, leadership, and performance behaviours consistent with pathway cultural expectations.</li></ul>
<b>Selection and talent identification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Lead a transparent and documented selection process based on approved criteria.</li><li>Work closely with academy coaches, school leaders and pathway staff to identify and track potential talent.</li><li>Ensure smooth transition of identified players into next-stage programs such as the Junior Academy and national opportunities.</li></ul>

<b>Talent Identification &amp; Progression</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Manage and develop assistant coaches and support staff, in conjunction with RV head of elite pathways.</li> <li>Provide clear direction, delegation and performance expectations across all roles.</li> <li>Ensure coordinated delivery of coaching, medical, welfare and analysis support.</li> </ul>
<b>Stakeholder Engagement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Build strong relationships with schools, parents, clubs, and pathway delivery partners.</li> <li>Share clear and timely communication about program commitments, expectations and progress.</li> <li>Represent the program professionally in all interactions and reporting responsibilities.</li> </ul>
