## CHILD SAFETY OFFICER/MEMBER PROTECTION INFORMATION OFFICER

## **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

POSITION	Child Safety Officer (CSO) / Member Protection Information Officer (MPIO)
REPORTS TO	Club/Association Committee
PURPOSE	The CSO/MPIO role is a volunteer role appointed by the Clubs' Committee. The role will serve as the first point of contact for club community members and others who have concerns about a child or young person within the club and provide advice and support to assist that person with making a report.
	The CSO/MPIO will lead the child safety message and ensure that the club/association has implemented practices and procedures in line with Rugby Australia and the State Child Safe Standards.
DUTIES	<ul> <li>Communicate and promote awareness and understanding of Safeguarding Policy and Procedures within club/association.</li> <li>Help adults at the Club understand their obligations to protect children and young people and promote their rights, creating a welcoming and safe environment for children and young people.</li> <li>Be the point of contact for all safeguarding of children and young people matters.</li> <li>Advise the Committee on roles that require a Working with Children Checks</li> <li>Ensure the club undertakes correct screening of people in accordance with the current safeguarding laws and legislation and that appropriate records are maintained.</li> <li>Attend Committee meetings and ensure that child safety is a standing agenda item for each meeting and all decisions are being made with the safeguarding of children and young people in mind.</li> <li>Work with the Committee to assess risks to children and young people and develop strategies and action plans to minimise the risks.</li> <li>Ensure all complaints, allegations and/or suspicion of Prohibited Conduct are reported to the Police and/or Rugby Australia's Report a Concern</li> </ul>
ROLE REQUIREMENT	<ul> <li>Must have a valid Working with Children Check (or equivalent).</li> <li>Undertake training on safeguarding and/or child safety issues, as directed by the Club, Association, Member Union and Rugby Australia.</li> </ul>
TRAINING	<ul> <li>Rugby Australia Code of Conduct online module</li> <li>Rugby Australia Child &amp; Young Person Safeguarding online module</li> </ul>
