

IF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY OCCURS CALL TRIPLE ZERO (000) IMMEDIATELY AND ASK FOR AN AMBULANCE

YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1. Name of ground or venue 4. Nearest cross street
- 2. Suburb
- 3. Street Name

- 5. Emergency vehicle access point (if there is one)
- 6. Phone number you are calling from

BE NEAR THE PATIENT WHEN YOU CALL. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- 1. What is the problem?

 3. Are they breathing?
- 2. How old is the patient? 4. Are they conscious?

THE ABOVE CAN BE APPLIED TO A HELICOPTER CALL OUT AS WELL. ADDITIONALLY, CLUBS SHOULD HAVE A CROWD CONTROL METHOD THAT CAN BE READILY DEPLOYED.

AS A GENERAL SUGGESTION THE MIDDLE OF THE RUGBY FIELD AS THE LANDING PAD SHOULD WORK IF NO OVERHEAD WIRES EXIST AND THE PERIMETER IS ABLE TO BE CLEARED.

> An ambulance will be dispatched based on the location and information you provide.

Stay on the line and the Triple Zero (000) call taker will provide first aid information to assist the patient until a paramedic arrives.
