

**Club Player Mascot Promotion  
(Promotion)**

**Terms and Conditions**

<b>Who is running the Promotion?</b>	Rugby Australia Ltd (ABN 36 002 898 544), PO BOX 800, Surry Hills NSW 2010 (the <b>Promoter</b> ).
<b>When will the Promotion start and end?</b>	The Promotion will start at 8am AEST on Friday May 15, 2026 and end at 5pm on Sunday May 31, 2026 (the <b>Promotion Period</b> ).
<b>Who can enter?</b>	<p>Entry is open to rugby union clubs located in Australia running the Harvey Norman Get into Rugby program and who hold at least bronze status per the 'Club Impact Program / Club Development Health Check' that can be found here <a href="https://clubhub.rugby/club-impact-program">https://clubhub.rugby/club-impact-program</a> (or equivalent status as determined by Promoter) (<b>Rugby Clubs</b>).</p> <p>A Rugby Club may submit one (1) entry only, which must be submitted by an authorised representative of the Rugby Club aged 18 years or over (<b>Authorised Representative</b> or <b>Entrant</b>). By submitting an entry, the Authorised Representative warrants that they have authority to enter the Promotion on behalf of the Rugby Club and to bind the Rugby Club to these Terms and Conditions.</p> <p>The following persons are not eligible to submit an entry on behalf of a Rugby Club:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) management, an employee, director or contractor of the Promoter or Rugby Australia, its related entities or other agencies, firms or companies associated with the Promotion (including suppliers of the prize);</li> <li>(b) a spouse, de-facto spouse, parent, guardian, child or sibling (whether natural or by adoption) of a person referred to in (a) above; or</li> <li>(c) persons who have breached the terms and conditions of any promotion run by or on behalf of the Promoter,</li> </ul> <p>(each an "<b>Excluded Person</b>").</p> <p>The Promoter has the right to determine whether an Authorised Representative or a Rugby Club is eligible in its absolute discretion.</p>
<b>Entry instructions</b>	<p>To enter and be eligible to participate in the Promotion, the Rugby Club must during the Promotion Period:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) create a video between 30 seconds and 90 seconds in duration explaining why the Rugby Club loves the Harvey Norman Get into Rugby program and why others should join the program;</li> <li>(b) publish the video on the Rugby Club's social media account(s) (<b>Submitted Video</b>);</li> <li>(c) complete and submit the official online entry form for the Promotion made available by the Promoter <a href="#">here</a>, including a link to the Submitted Video;</li> <li>(d) ensure the entry is submitted by an Authorised Representative of the Rugby Club; and</li> <li>(e) accept these Terms and Conditions.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Entry Warranties</b></p>	<p>By submitting an entry into the Promotion, the Authorised Representative warrants on behalf of the Rugby Club that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) the Rugby Club owns, or has obtained all necessary rights, licences, consents and permissions required to submit the Submitted Video and the entry and grant the rights contemplated by these Terms and Conditions;</li> <li>(b) all persons appearing in the Submitted Video have consented to being filmed and to the Promoter using, publishing, reproducing and communicating the Submitted Video in accordance with these Terms and Conditions;</li> <li>(c) where any person appearing in the Submitted Video is under 18 years of age, the Rugby Club has obtained the prior consent of that person's parent or legal guardian;</li> <li>(d) the Rugby Club has obtained all necessary parent or legal guardian consents, approvals and authorisations required for each Eligible Participant to participate in the Mascot Experience and comply with these Terms and Conditions;</li> <li>(e) the Submitted Video entry does not infringe the intellectual property rights, privacy rights or any other rights of any third party;</li> <li>(f) the Submitted Video entry does not contain any unlawful, defamatory, offensive or inappropriate material;</li> <li>(g) the Submitted Video entry does not contain any third party copyrighted material (including music) unless the Rugby Club has obtained all necessary rights and permissions; and</li> <li>(h) the Rugby Club will provide evidence of any consent or permission referred to above upon request by the Promoter.</li> </ul> <p>The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably believes these warranties have been breached.</p>
<p><b>What kind of Promotion is this?</b></p>	<p>This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner.</p> <p>The Promoter may also use knowledge and information extraneous to the entry to assist with its judgment of an entrants eligibility for entry and potential selection as a winner. This includes, without limitation, the entrants and/or Rugby Clubs's compliance with Rugby Australia's Code of Conduct, any Promoter/Rugby Australia policies, child safeguarding and governance responsibilities.</p>
<p><b>How many winners will there be, and how will they be chosen?</b></p>	<p>There will be up to three (3) winning Rugby Clubs. However, the Promoter reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to select additional winning Rugby Clubs where the Promoter considers it appropriate having regard to the Criteria.</p> <p>All valid entries received will be judged by the Promoter (or persons nominated by the Promoter) based on the quality, creativity and originality of the Submitted Video, the Rugby Club's demonstrated passion for the Harvey Norman Get into Rugby program and the extent to which the submission positively promotes participation in rugby union (<b>Criteria</b>).</p> <p>A panel of judges from, or persons nominated by, the Promoter will select the winners by assessing which of all valid entries best satisfy the Criteria. The Promoter may also use knowledge and information</p>

	extraneous to the entry to assist with its judgment of the relevant Rugby Club's eligibility for entry and potential selection as a winner.
<b>Where will the Promotion be advertised?</b>	<p>The Promotion is advertised via:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Promoter's social media accounts; and</li> <li>(b) the website at <a href="https://australia.rugby/community/player-mascot-campaign">https://australia.rugby/community/player-mascot-campaign</a></li> </ul>
<b>What can I win?</b>	<p>The successful Rugby Club(s) will receive the opportunity for up to 46 Eligible Participants to participate as player mascots at a Wallabies match during the 2026 season (<b>Mascot Experience</b>).</p> <p>The Promoter may determine, in its absolute discretion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) the number of Eligible Participants allocated to each Rugby Club; and</li> <li>(b) the relevant Wallabies match at which the Mascot Experience will occur.</li> </ul> <p>The Mascot Experience is subject to availability, operational requirements, venue requirements, safeguarding requirements, security requirements, player availability and any broadcast requirements.</p> <p>The Mascot Experience includes one (1) match ticket for each Eligible Participant and one (1) match ticket for the parent or legal guardian attending with that Eligible Participant for the relevant Wallabies match. The Mascot Experience does not include travel, accommodation, meals, uniforms or any ancillary costs unless expressly stated by the Promoter.</p> <p>The Promoter reserves the right to vary, substitute, postpone or cancel any aspect of the Mascot Experience where reasonably required for operational, safety, security or other reasons beyond the Promoter's reasonable control.</p> <p>For the purposes of this clause <b>Eligible Participant</b> means a participant who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) is aged 6 or 7 years old at the time of the relevant Wallabies match;</li> <li>(b) is registered with the relevant Rugby Club in the Harvey Norman Get into Rugby program for 2026;</li> <li>(c) has the consent of their parent or legal guardian to participate in the Mascot Experience and to these Terms and Conditions; and</li> <li>(d) satisfies any additional eligibility requirements reasonably determined by Rugby Australia.</li> </ul> <p>Each Rugby Club is solely responsible for obtaining all parent or legal guardian consents and approvals required for an Eligible Participant to participate in the Mascot Experience, including completion of any consent forms, medical forms, liability waivers, media releases or other documentation reasonably required by the Promoter.</p> <p>The Promoter reserves the right to refuse participation in the Mascot Experience where:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) any required documentation is not completed or provided to the Promoter's satisfaction;</li> <li>(b) the Promoter is unable to verify the eligibility of a participant;</li> </ul>

	<p>(c) the relevant Rugby Club has not obtained all required parent or legal guardian consents or approvals; or</p> <p>(d) participation may present a safety, safeguarding or operational concern.</p>
<b>How many times can I enter?</b>	<p>Only one (1) entry per Rugby Club is permitted. The entry must be submitted by an Authorised Representative of the Rugby Club.</p> <p>If multiple entries are received from the same Rugby Club, the Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, accept the first valid entry received and disregard any subsequent entries.</p>
<b>How are the winners of the Promotion decided, and what happens next?</b>	<p>After the end of the Promotion Period, the panel of judges will determine which Authorised Representatives (and the relevant Rugby Clubs) will win the prize by no later than Monday June 9 at 5pm. A staff member from the Promoter will endeavour to contact the winning Rugby Club and inform them they are the winner by email or phone call by no later than Friday June 12 at 5pm. The winning Rugby Clubs must confirm their acknowledgment as the winner by Monday 15 June at 5pm, failing which the Promoter may in its absolute discretion discard that Authorised Representative and the relevant Rugby Club) as the winner and allocate the prize to the next best Authorised Representative (and relevant Rugby Club). An Authorised Representative (and relevant Rugby Club) which fails to confirm its acknowledgment as the winner by such time will no longer be deemed the "Winner".</p> <p>Once the winning Rugby Club has confirmed their acknowledged as the winner, a representative of the Promoter will contact the relevant Rugby Club to make arrangements for the claiming and delivery of the prize. If Authorised Representative and/or the relevant Rugby Club does not reasonably cooperate with such arrangements in a timely manner, the Promoter reserves the right to discard the prize.</p>

### Acceptance

- 1 These Terms and Conditions incorporate and must be read together with the details outlined in the table above and the relevant online form referred to in the 'Entry instructions' above. Information about prizes and how to enter forms part of these Terms and Conditions. By entering, the Authorised Representative (on behalf of the relevant Rugby Club and Eligible Participants) accept these Terms and Conditions.

### Entry

- 2 Entries must be received during the Promotion Period. Entries received by the Promoter will be considered final. Entries are deemed to be received at the time they are received by the Promoter's database and not at the time of submission by the entrant.
- 3 Entries must be submitted by an Authorised Representative on behalf of the relevant Rugby Club in their own name. Entrants who enter using multiple email/postal addresses, phone numbers, social media accounts or aliases may be disqualified. The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an entrant to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and will render all entries submitted by that entrant invalid.
- 4 The Promoter is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, misdirected, incorrectly submitted delayed or illegible entries, correspondence or claims for prizes due to error, omission, tampering, theft, destruction or otherwise including failure of entry forms being forwarded to the draw location (where applicable).
- 5 Entrants agree that they are fully responsible for all content and materials they submit and the Promoter shall not be liable for such to the full extent permitted by law. Entrants warrant and agree that they will not submit any content that: (i) is unlawful or fraudulent; (ii) the Promoter may reasonably deem to be in breach of any intellectual property, privacy or proprietary rights; or (iii) is defamatory, obscene, derogatory, pornographic, sexually inappropriate, violent, abusive, harassing,

threatening, objectionable with respect to race, religion, origin or gender. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which it considers (in its absolute discretion) does not comply with these terms and conditions of entry.

- 6 All entries become the property of the Promoter. As a condition of entering into this Promotion, entrants agree to grant the Promoter a non-exclusive, royalty-free, licence to the Promoter to use and sub-licence the use of any image rights, copyright or other intellectual property rights in and to the entry submitted and any related content. Without limiting this, the Promoter may use entry content for any and all purposes including commercial purposes. Entrants warrant that entry content is lawful and not misleading and that the Promoter's use of such content will not infringe the rights of any third parties. The Promoter has no obligation to credit entrants as the author of any content submitted and may otherwise do any acts or omissions which would otherwise constitute an infringement of any moral rights an entrant may have as an author of content.

### **Prizes**

- 7 If for any reason a winner does not take a prize (or an element of a prize) at the time stipulated, then the prize (or that element of the prize) will be forfeited and will not be redeemable for cash.
- 8 The Promoter takes no responsibility where it is unable to contact prize winners who have not provided correct or complete contact details. If an entrant's contact details change during the promotional period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter. A request to modify any entry information should be directed to Promoter.
- 9 If a prize is unavailable, for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter may offer an alternative prize of equivalent value and specification. If a prize includes a match/festival/event/activity and that match/festival/event/activity is cancelled, abandoned, called off or postponed for any reason, that prize will be forfeited, and no cash or replacement prize will be offered.
- 10 It is a condition of accepting a prize that the winner must comply with all of the conditions of use for the prize, and the prize supplier's requirements.
- 11 If a prize includes vouchers, gift cards or tickets, the Promoter is not liable for and will not provide any replacement prize if they are stolen, forged, damaged or tampered with any way once awarded or are not activated or used before the stated expiry date. Any prize including tickets are subject to the event venue and ticket terms and conditions, including any applicable age restriction. The Promoter and event organisers hereby expressly reserve the right to eject any winner (and/or their guest) for any inappropriate behaviour, including intoxication, whilst participating in the event. Where alcohol is available as part of a prize, it will be served in line with the responsible service of alcohol guidelines carried out by the venue staff and management. The Promoter is not responsible for how a venue conducts and executes its responsible service of alcohol guidelines. Venue staff and management reserve the right to refuse service of alcohol to any prize winner/s or their accompanying guest/s if they are deemed to be inebriated.

### **General**

- 12 The relevant Rugby Club, its Authorised Representative and each participant in the Promotion agree to participate in all publicity, photography, film and other promotional activity as the Promoter requires, without any compensation. The relevant Rugby Club, its Authorised Representative and each participant in these activities accept that they have no ownership rights in the images which shall be the sole and absolute property of the Promoter and/or the Promoter's official photography/videography partner. The relevant Rugby Club, its Authorised Representative and each participant in the Promotion consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, age, image and/or voice in any publicity, promotional or advertising activity in all forms of media including without limitation in press, magazines, outdoor, direct mail, PR, posters, online, social & literature for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter. Without limiting the above, the Promoter and any third party acting on its behalf may use, publish, reproduce and communicate the Submitted Video in any media for promotional and marketing purposes.
- 13 If the Authorised Representative or the relevant Rugby Club are deemed by the Promoter to breach these Terms and Conditions including if they are unable to accept the prize specified by the Promoter, the relevant entry may be discarded. The Promoter may, at any time, require the Authorised Representative or the relevant Rugby Club to produce documentation to establish to the Promoter's satisfaction the validity of the entry (including documentation establishing identity, age,

place of residence and place of employment). Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not waive those rights. The prizes will only be awarded following all validation and verification requirements of the Promoter being met to its satisfaction. In the event that an Authorised Representative and/or relevant Rugby Club cannot provide suitable validation or verification, they will forfeit their right to a prize and no substitute will be offered. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.

- 14 The Authorised Representative, the relevant Rugby Club and any participants in the Promotion must not:
- (a) tamper with the entry process;
  - (b) engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Promotion;
  - (c) act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner;
  - (d) do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Promoter or any of its related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this Promotion;
  - (e) breach any law; or
  - (f) behave in a way that is otherwise inappropriate.

The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

- 15 The Promoter's decision in connection with all aspects of this Promotion is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 16 Prizes cannot be transferred or exchanges nor redeemed for cash. Without limiting any other term of these Terms and Conditions, all prizes (and elements of prizes) must be taken as and when specified, or will be forfeited with no replacement. The prize values are correct as at the date of preparing these Terms and Conditions and include any applicable GST. The Promoter is not responsible for any change in prize value. The Authorised Representative and relevant Rugby Club agree that if a prize (or element of a prize) is unavailable for any reason the Promoter may provide another item of equal or higher value, subject to any necessary approval by the state/territory gaming authorities.
- 17 By accepting or participating in any prize, the winning Rugby Club, Authorised Representative and Eligible Participants accept these Terms and Conditions.
- 18 If this Promotion cannot run as planned for any reason beyond the Promoter's control, for example due to software, hardware or communications issues, unauthorised intervention, tampering, fraud or technical failure, the Promoter may end, change, suspend or cancel the Promotion or disqualify affected entries/entrants, subject to any necessary approval by the state/territory gaming authorities.
- 19 The Promoter is not responsible for any tax implications arising from a Rugby Club winning a prize. Each Rugby Club and Authorised Representative should seek independent financial advice. If for GST purposes this Promotion results in any supply being made for non-monetary consideration, each Rugby Club and Authorised Representative must follow the Australian Taxation Office's stated view that where the parties are at arm's length, goods and services exchanged are of equal GST inclusive market values.

### **Liability**

- 20 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions restricts, excludes or modifies any consumer rights under any statute including the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth).
- 21 Subject to the previous paragraph, the Promoter and the agencies and companies associated with this Promotion are not liable (including in negligence) for any loss (including indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense, damage, personal injury, illness or death suffered in connection with this Promotion or any prize, except for any liability which under statute cannot be excluded (in which case that liability is limited to the greatest extent allowed by law).
- 22 Without limiting the previous paragraph, the Promoter and the agencies and companies associated with this Promotion are not liable for any loss of, damage to or delay in delivery of prizes. Prizes will only be delivered to addresses in Australia.

- 23 The Promoter has no control over communications networks and is not liable for any problems associated with them due to traffic congestion, technical malfunction or otherwise. Costs associated with accessing the Internet (e.g. website or social media platform) may vary depending on the Internet service provider used, and those costs are the responsibility of the entrant. The Promoter is not liable for any consequences of user error including (without limitation) costs incurred.
- 24 The Promoter may communicate or advertise this Promotion using Facebook, Twitter ('X'), YouTube, TikTok, Snapchat and/or Instagram. However, the Promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with either of those platforms. Entrants, the relevant Rugby Club and Club Supporters provide their information to the Promoter and not to such platforms. You completely release such platforms from any and all liability.
- 25 As a condition of accepting a prize, the relevant Rugby Club, its Authorised Representative, the winning Rugby Club and any participants in the Mascot Experience must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter and/or prize suppliers in their absolute discretion, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.

#### **Collection and use of personal information**

- 26 All entries and copyright subsisting in an entry will become the property of the Promoter. The personal information of Entrants and each participant in the Promotion (including any Eligible Participant) will be collected by or on behalf of the Promoter to enable it to administer and promote the Promotion and the winners of the Promotion. The personal information of entrants (and Eligible Participants) may be provided to others assisting in the conduct of the Promotion, including the Promotion administrator, suppliers and deliverers, and to authorities that regulate the Promotion. Additionally, such personal information may be provided to sponsors of the Promotion. Entrants and Eligible Participants acknowledge that their personal information may be supplied to organisations outside of Australia and they provide their consent for this to occur by participating in the Promotion. The Promoter cannot guarantee that any overseas recipient will not breach the Australian Privacy Principles.
- 27 Personal information will be collected, stored and used in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) and the Promoter's privacy policy available on the Promoter's website at <https://australia.rugby/privacy>.

#### **General**

- 28 These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of NSW. The Promoter and all entrants irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of NSW.
- 29 These rules are Terms and Conditions and constitute the entire terms and conditions between the entrant and the Promoter with respect to the Promotion. The Promoter may alter, modify, or amend these Terms and Conditions at its sole discretion and will only provide entrants with notice of substantial amendments (subject to the approval of the authorities that have issued permits for the conduct of the Promotion).
- 30 Each entrant warrants that:
- (a) they have the full power and capacity to grant the rights, warranties and consents set out in these Terms and Conditions;
  - (b) the entry is not, and its use by the Promoter will not be, in breach of any third party intellectual property rights;
  - (c) it will fully indemnify the Promoter against any loss or damage suffered by the Promoter;
  - (d) in the event that any of the warranties given by the entrant are false; and
  - (e) as a result of any breach of these Terms and Conditions by the entrant.
