Youth Teams

- Coach the NSW team to achieve NSW Rugby Union performance targets.
- Prepare for and manage the NSW team through the RA National 'Battle of the Border' Championship in 2022. **(The program is still in its infancy due to Covid but will run from approx. 10th January through to early February 2022 - depending on Border openings after Covid restrictions)**
- Attend Pre-Competition Selection Tournaments hosted by NSW Rugby Union (State Championships 20th – 21st Nov. 2021 [Head Coach only] and SJRU 7s Gala days [Head and Assistant Coach] 13/14, 27/28 Nov. and 4/5 Dec in Sydney)
- Contribute to the ongoing development and review of the State Program.
- Provide leadership and support the direction of the NSW Coaching Strategy through all program delivery.

Essential Skills & Experience

- Rugby Union coaching at a State or Regional level through Country Rugby Union Suburban Rugby Union, Sydney Rugby Union or NSW Schools Rugby Union player pathways. **(Coaches already appointed to coaching roles within this pathway are able to apply for these coaching positions)**
- Demonstrated experience of developing athletes in a performance-based Rugby Union environment.
- Agree to display and carry out the 'Character and Values' that come with representing NSW Rugby Union as an organisation
