- Adults should listen to you when decisions affect you

YOUR RUGBY EXPERIENCE

- You should feel safe at training, games and events
- You should feel safe online too
- Adults should coach and support you respectfully
- You should feel comfortable around other children and young people

IT'S OK TO SPEAK UP

- If something happens that is upsetting or hurtful, speak up
- Tell a parent/guardian, friend or trusted adult
- Tell a trusted person at your club (coach, team manager or Child Safety Contact)
- You can also report a concern online (Rugby Australia)
